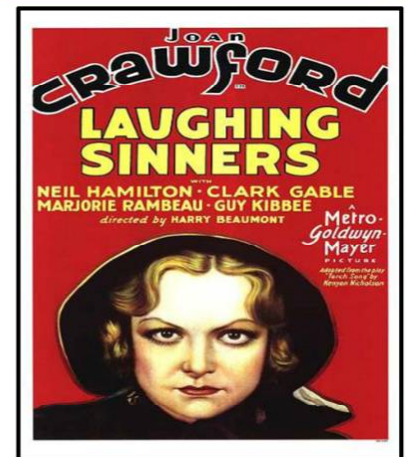
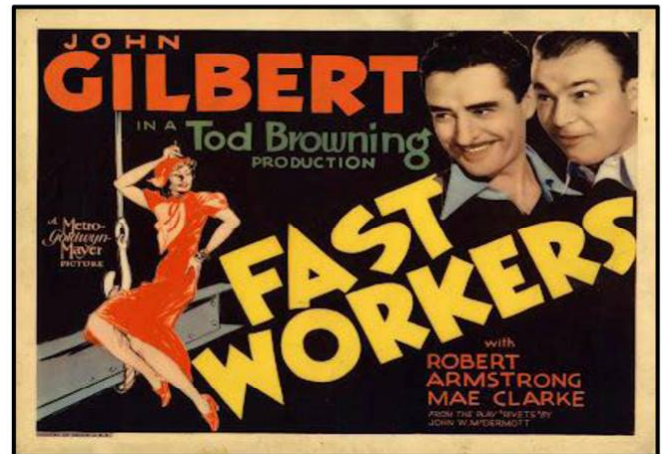
30 MINUTE INTERMISSION BETWEEN FILMS

It's the story of a young woman (Crawford) who, when done wrong by her lover (Hamilton), joins the Salvation Army when she meets reformed evangelist Gable. This was the follow-up film to *Dance, Fools, Dance*, made in the same year. When the audience saw the chemistry between these two dynamic up-and-coming stars, they clamoured to see more. Not the type of role in which film viewers of any era were expecting to see a young Clark.
